#### INTRODUCTION

Probation and Aftercare Service is a criminal justice agency in the State Department for Correctional Services, Ministry of Interior and National Administration, Kenya.

## WHAT IS AFTERCARE?

#### What is Aftercare?

Aftercare is a pogramme that resettles, reintegrates, empowers and rehabilitates offenders leaving various correctional institutions. It aims at providing services intended to prevent offenders leaving correctional institutions from regressing to a life of dependency and custodial care.

#### The role of Probation

Probation and Aftercare Service has a crucial role to play in supporting offenders leaving custodial and noncustodial institutions adjust to normal life.

### The objectives of Aftercare are to:

- Resettle, reintegrate and offenders existing corrective institutions.
- Empower offenders with life skills, education and training.
- Continue the rehabilitation of offenders in the community as an aftercare measure.
- Provide support to offenders living in the community to mitigate victimization and social stigma.

#### Who is a Probation Officer?

This is an officer appointed under the of Offenders to Probation Act supervise offenders. He/she is a highly trained person in community based correctional methods. His/her task and responsibility is to ensure that offenders placed under his/her are well integrated the care in community where they belong.

## Who qualifies as an Aftercare supervisee?

Aftercare beneficiaries comprise persons leaving:

- Remand
- Probation Hostels
- Prison
- Psychiatrics offenders
- Youth Corrective Training Center
- Borstal
- Rehabilitation School

## AFTERCARE SERVICES

#### **Services**

The Aftercare Programme service entail:

- Preparation and submission of Power of Mercy Pre-release Advisory Reports to Power of Mercy Advisory Committee
- Preparation and submission of Power of Mercy Pre-release Advisory Reports for Special Category Offenders to Power of Mercy Advisory Committee
- Preparation and submission of Environmental Adjustment Reports to Probation Hostel, Borstal Institutions and Rehabilitation Schools
- Supervision of offenders released by Presidential Release Warrant, Court Order, Board of Visitors License, Discharge Board Releases Warrant
- Voluntary supervision of offenders released from custodial institutions
- Resettlement and reintegration of aftercare supervisees into the community
- Rehabilitation of aftercare supervisees in the community
- Reconciliation of victims and aftercare supervisees
- Provision of Certificate of Completion

#### **Duration of Aftercare**

The period of aftercare shall be accordance to provision of various release document in the case of mandatory supervision, but shall not exceed two years.

### **Principles**

The Principles of Aftercare are:

- Involvement of the community in resettlement, reintegration and rehabilitation of offenders
- Safeguarding the rights and interests of aftercare supervisees vis-a-vis the rights of victims and the community
- Sensitization and awareness creation on the benefits of aftercare
- Identification and assessment of risks and needs of aftercare supervisees
